

# O tempo das cerejas - DIY

## Materials

Red cardboard 50x65  
Pencil and ruler  
Scissors and glue  
Needle and thread  
19 paper sheets A4

Cut 

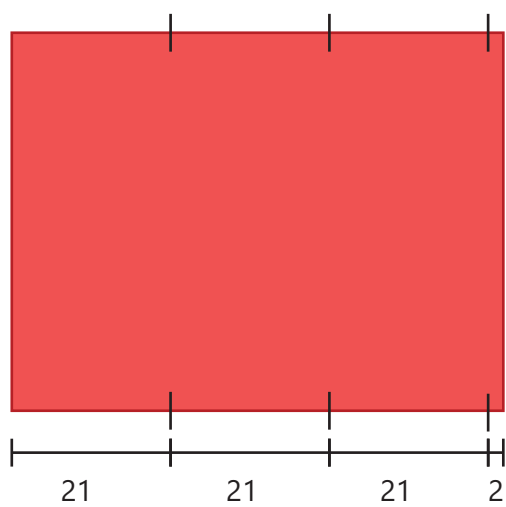
Fold 

The measurements are in centimeters



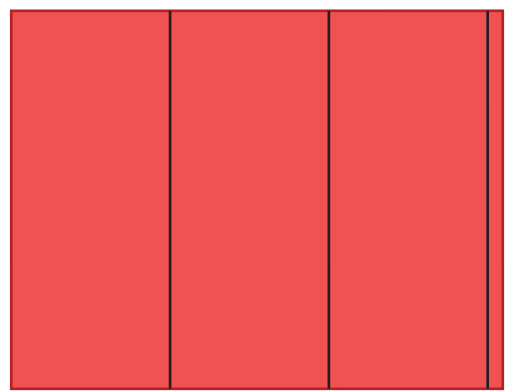
The following process will be carried out for the use of all available notebooks. If you intend to print only a few notebooks, for each notebook removed, a fold will also be removed.

## 1º – Cut the cardboard



With the cardboard open and positioned horizontally, we used the ruler and a pencil to make the first markings.

We make three 21 cm markings along the longest side of the cardboard. Both top and bottom sides.



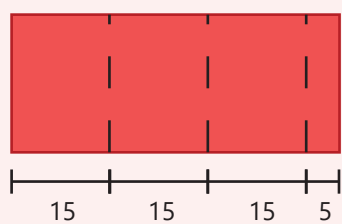
We join the markings with a continuous line to indicate the cutting zone.

With the help of scissors we cut following the line we made.

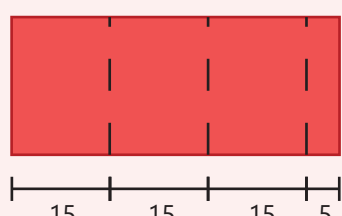


We will have in hand 3 strips of 21cm x 50 cm of red cardboard.

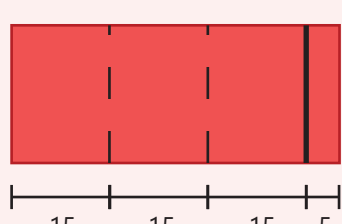
## 2º– Fold the cardboard



Again, we start by making markings on the top and bottom of the cards. This time there are three 15 cm markings and one 5 cm mark at the end.



The markings are made with a dashed line, so that the cardboard is folded.



The smallest folds will serve to join the cardboards in the next step.

Only on the last strip, the extra 5 cm are cut.

## 3º– Join the cardboard



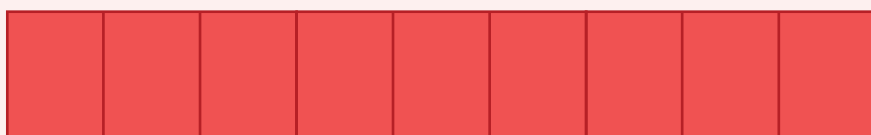
We position the cards in order, leaving the smallest fold on the right side, and leaving the smallest card on the extreme right side.

Apply glue to the smallest folds, those of 5 cm (marked in blue) and attach them to the fold of the next cardboard.

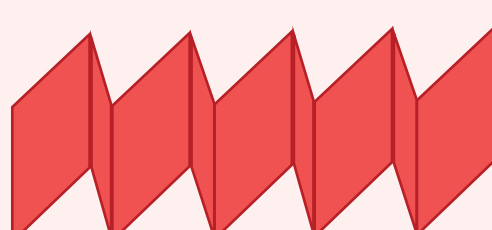
We let the glue dry before moving on to the next step.

## 4º– Refold the cardboard

The glued card must have 8 folds and 9 rectangles, all rectangles are 15 cm x 21 cm.



For the final folding, we will fold the cardboard in zigzag format.

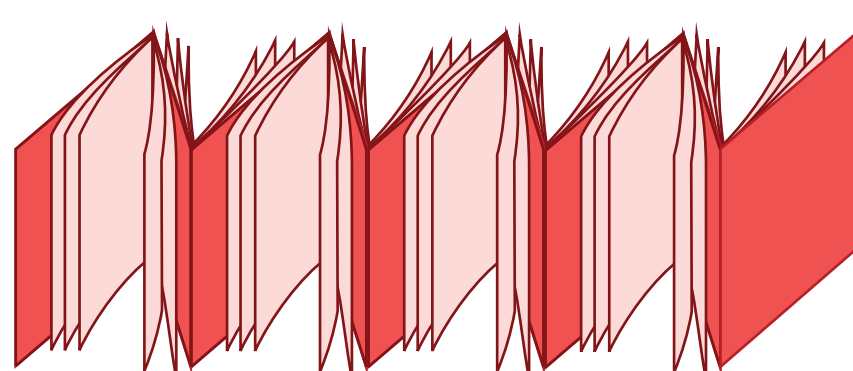


## 5º– Book pages

Notebooks must be printed in front and back format.

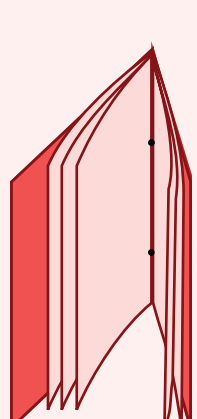
To start, we organize the texts in order.

Each text must go within a single fold.

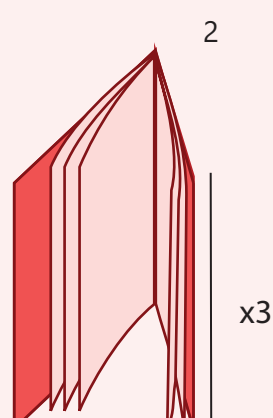


## 6º– Sewing

For sewing, it is recommended for the process to be carried out for one notebook at a time.

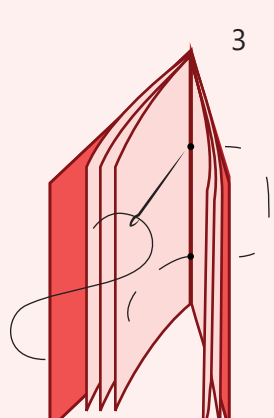


Before starting sewing, it is necessary to drill 2 holes with the needle through the core and the cover. The holes should be about 11 cm apart.



The amount of thread required for each notebook is the same as 3 times the height of the notebook.

With the thread on the needle we can start sewing.

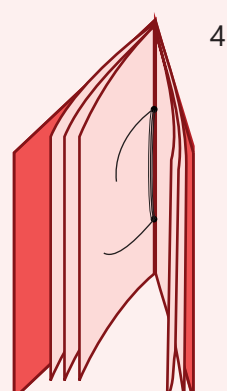


Start sewing at the upper inner point. We pull the thread to the next point, leaving enough thread behind to later make a knot (about 10 cm).

The needle goes to the outer part, where it will enter the lower hole.

Again, the needle enters the upper inner hole.

The process is repeated 2 more times to ensure a safe seam.



Finally, we remove the needle and tie a knot with both ends.

Repeat the process for the following notebooks
